Begell House, Inc. ("Begell House"), owner and publisher of the Journal, is pleased to consider for publication in the Journal the previously unpublished original work described above (text plus other materials to be published as part of the work, such as, for example, tables, figures, graphs, charts, drawings, photographs, and other illustrations; digital media works; and an abstract) (the "Contribution"). To enable Begell House to disseminate the Contribution to the fullest extent possible, Begell House requires this Copyright Transfer Agreement be signed by the Contributor and delivered to Begell House prior to publication of the Contribution. If and when the Contribution is accepted for publication in the Journal, the following terms and conditions shall become effective as of the date of Contributor's execution of this Agreement:

1. Transfer of Copyright. Contributor transfers and assigns to Begell House all right, title, and interest in the copyright, and all of the rights comprised therein and all remedies afforded by law, throughout the world (for U.S. Government works, see paragraph 3 below) in and to the Contribution and any revisions thereof prepared and submitted by Contributor, including, but not limited to, the exclusive right to reproduce, publish, republish, prepare foreign language translations and other derivative works, distribute, sell, license, transfer, transmit, and publicly display copies of, and otherwise use the Contribution, in whole or in part, alone or in compilations, by any method, device, or process and in all formats and media now known or later conceived or developed; and the exclusive right to license or otherwise authorize others to do any or all of the foregoing; and the right to assign and transfer any or all of the rights granted herein. To the extent that any right now or in the future existing under copyright is not specifically granted to Begell House by the terms of this Agreement, such right shall be deemed to have been granted hereunder.

2. Grant to Contributor. Begell House grants to Contributor a non-exclusive, non-transferable, perpetual right and license, without charge, to use and reproduce print form copies of all or part of the Contribution (after initial publication in the Journal): (a) in any literary work written or edited by an Author; (b) for an Author's use in classroom teaching to be distributed to students free of charge; and (c) for internal non-commercial distribution to an Author's colleagues within the institution at which the Author is employed for the Author's personal or professional use or for the advancement of scholarly or scientific research or study; *provided, however*, that in each instance all such copies include the copyright notice that appears on the issue of the Journal in which the Contribution is first published and a full citation to the Journal as published by Begell House.

3. U.S. Government Works. If the Contribution is designated above as a U.S. Government work, Contributor hereby certifies that all the Authors were officers or employees of the United States Government at the time the Contribution was prepared and that it was prepared by the Authors as part of their official government duties. Begell House acknowledges that under the Copyright Act of 1976, as amended, United States copyright protection is not available for U.S. Government works, which are considered to be in the public domain in the United States. U.S. Government works may, however, be protected in other countries under foreign copyright laws governing ownership of foreign copyrights in U.S. Government works. Accordingly, if the Contribution is a U.S. Government work, paragraph 1 shall apply only outside the United States.

4. Works Prepared Under U.S. Government Contract or Grant. If the Contribution was prepared under a U. S. Government contract or grant, Begell House acknowledges that the United States Government reserves a royalty-free, nonexclusive and irrevocable right to reproduce, publish, or otherwise use the Contribution for official United States Government purposes only, and to authorize others to do so, if the U.S. Government contract or grant so requires. Upon request, Contributor will provide Begell House with the contract number of the U.S. Government contract or grant and/or a copy of the contract.

5. Permissions. If the Contribution contains copyrighted material (text or graphic) owned by others, then Contributor, at Contributor's expense, shall obtain written permission from the copyright owner, in form and scope acceptable to Begell House, to include and reproduce such copyrighted material in the Contribution and in the Journal. Contributor shall deliver all written permissions to Begell House together with delivery of the manuscript of the Contribution. Delivery of all required written permissions is a condition of publication of the Contribution in the Journal.

6. Copyediting; Page Proofs. Begell House may copyedit the Contribution for clarity, brevity, grammar, usage, and conformity of style as Begell House deems advisable for production and publication in the Journal. The Corresponding Author shall review and make any corrections and proposed changes to page proofs of the Contribution forwarded by Begell House, and shall timely return corrected proofs to Begell House as directed, time being of the essence. If extensive changes (other than corrections) are made to page proofs by the Corresponding Author, Begell House may charge to Contributor the cost of making such changes. If corrected proofs are not timely returned, Begell House may proceed with the publication of the Contribution as it deems appropriate.

7. Credit; Use Of Name and Likeness. Each Author will receive credit as an author of the Contribution when it is published in the Journal; the form and placement of the credit will be determined by Begell House. Each Author grants Begell House the right to use his/her name, likeness, biographical information, and professional credits on copies of the Contribution and the Journal and in connection with the exercise of any other of Begell House's rights granted hereunder and in advertising, marketing, and promotion in connection therewith, and to grant such rights to any licensees or assigns of Begell House.

8. Representations. Contributor warrants and represents that: (a) the rights in the Contribution transferred herein to Begell House have not been previously assigned, transferred or otherwise encumbered; (b) the Contribution is the original work of the Authors (except for copyrighted material owned by others for which written permission has been obtained) and has not been previously published in any form; (c) the Contribution does not infringe the copyright or violate any proprietary rights, rights of privacy or publicity, or any other rights of any third party, and does not contain any material that is libelous or otherwise contrary to law; and (d) all statements in the Contribution asserted as fact are either true or based upon generally accepted professional research practices, and no formula or procedure contained therein would cause injury if used in accordance with

the instructions and/or warnings included in the Contribution. If the Corresponding Author signs this Agreement on behalf of all the Authors, then the Corresponding Author warrants and represents that he/she has the full right, power and authority to enter into this Agreement and to convey the rights granted herein on behalf of all the Authors and he/she signs this Agreement as the duly authorized agent for and on behalf of all the Authors. If the Contribution is a work made for hire, Employer warrants and represents that it has the full right, power and authority to enter into this Agreement and to convey the rights granted herein. Contributor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Editor and Begell House, its affiliates, assigns and licensees, against any losses, liabilities, damages, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees and including any amounts paid in settlement, but only if consented thereto in writing by Contributor) arising from or resulting out of any claim or demand of any kind that, if sustained, would constitute a breach of any of Contributor's warranties.

9. Miscellaneous; Termination. This Agreement must be signed by all the Authors or by the Corresponding Author on behalf of all the Authors (and by Employer, if the Contribution is a work made for hire) and delivered to Begell House as a condition of publication of the Contribution in the Journal. Begell House makes no guarantee that the Contribution will be published in the Journal. If, for any reason, the Contribution is not published in the Journal, then all rights in the Contribution transferred and assigned to Begell House hereunder shall revert to Contributor and this Agreement shall be of no further force and effect, and neither Begell House or Contributor will have any obligation to the other with respect to the Contribution. No amendment or modification of any provision of this Agreement shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and signed by the parties hereto. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to its subject matter, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, understandings, and representations relating thereto.
